# **GENERAL CATALOGUE**

In this catalogue, tickets within each price band are sorted firstly into company (i.e., pregrouping and pre-nationalisation), then British Railways regional order (i.e., Northern, Eastern, London Midland, Scottish, Southern and Western regions).

#### **ORDERING GUIDELINES**

Tickets from this catalogue will be processed on a 'First Come, First Served' automated basis. To give you the best chance of securing the tickets you want, use the online facility (using your email address and password), which many of you are now familiar with. Once an order has been submitted online, the system will inform you which tickets are available instantly. You can submit further orders from the same catalogue, which gives you the flexibility of ordering second choice tickets. Orders will be processed within three working days. Payment processes can be via: PayPal; Credit/Debit Cards (WorldPay Pay by Link); bank transfer or cheque.

We will continue to process orders received via email/telephone/post as soon as possible.

All tickets offered in this catalogue are in at least "very good" condition unless otherwise stated in the legend (see below).

**LEGEND** A: indicates ticket is unissued and has originated from an Audit Office

C: indicates ticket is creased F: indicates ticket is faded

**G:** indicates ticket is grubby or soiled **M:** indicates ticket has been mounted

An interesting 'modern' issue has just arrived for the collection. It is a 'Town Holiday Special' Monthly return with a green 'M' overprint on pink card with black text from ASHTON to Blackpool rubber date stamped 16-08-1980. The serial is low at 0008 and there is a National Location Code of 2880, which is not Ashton's. Ashton (Charlestown) was renamed in 1968 to its current name which is Ashton-Under- Lyne, therefore this 1980 contraction of the name is curious. Business at Ashton cannot have been that great, as a Sportis only was provided in the ticket office for 15 plus years with an Aptis being introduced in 2005 with the name 'Ashton U Lyne'. A useful addition.

Returning to the Plymouth area, we arrive at **ST. BUDEAUX G.W**. This station is now named **Ferry Road** and we hold a GWR single to Taunton in manuscript from the 'U' which was the Up Office. The ticket is dated 16-01-1959. The other issue held from the 'U' is a GWR pink single for a perambulator (not folding), a folding peramulator or a Folding Mail Cart when not folded to either Saltash or Plymouth North Road. These items were accompanying passenger at owners risk at a 'carriage' paid of 4d. Dated 11-03-19?8, the serial is 1674 and 'return' has been rubber stamped, obviously on the front. We must not forget that crossing the River Tamer had to be by train or the two ferries which operated from nearby or the Torpoint Ferry. It is impressive that all the text was made to fit on this issue. 4 B.R. issues are held from Ferry Road, the first is a day excursion to Saltash rubber date stamped 12-10-1965 and with an unknown NLC of 7517, serial 2085. Perhaps it was issued by the guard, the second is a cheap day to 'Plymouth N.Rd' dated 07-195?, a different NLC of 7496 and a low serial of 166. This one has a promient 'clerks mark', perhaps this was also issued on train. Next is a Forces Leave Single to Tavistock in manuscript dated 12-08-1961, with an NLC of 7507/U which was issued at the up office. Of course the journey would have been from Victoria Road. Finally a plain 'U' issue, for a pram in manuscript dated 29-03-60.


