## **GENERAL CATALOGUE**

In this catalogue, tickets within each price band are sorted firstly into company (i.e., pregrouping and pre-nationalisation), then British Railways regional order (i.e., Northern, Eastern, London Midland, Scottish, Southern and Western regions).

#### **ORDERING GUIDELINES**

Tickets from this catalogue will be processed on a 'First Come, First Served' automated basis. To give you the best chance of securing the tickets you want, use the online facility (using your email address and password), which many of you are now familiar with. Once an order has been submitted online, the system will inform you which tickets are available instantly. You can submit further orders from the same catalogue, which gives you the flexibility of ordering second choice tickets. Orders will be processed within three working days. Payment processes can be via: PayPal; Credit/Debit Cards (WorldPay Pay by Link); bank transfer or cheque.

We will continue to process orders received via email/telephone/post as soon as possible.

All tickets offered in this catalogue are in at least "very good" condition unless otherwise stated in the legend (see below).

**LEGEND** A: indicates ticket is unissued and has originated from an Audit Office

**G:** indicates ticket is grubby or soiled **M:** indicates ticket has been mounted

**We start** with another example of a modern pink one coupon Edmondson, this being a 'Super Circular Railride' from Manchester to Carlisle out via Preston, back via the S&C.and Leeds or vice versa. break of journey was permitted at Carlisle only. Ours is dated 09-06-1984 and has a serial of 0116, however the main point of interest is that we now have an undefined issue from Victoria.

Back to the Plymouth area and onto St.Budeaux. We start with a Southern railway 'HM Forces on leave' single complete with red SL overprint to Calstock dated 29-10-1950 and a serial of 0288. Next a S.Rly. child single to Tavistock dated 12-11-1963 with a serial of 1886, clearly a demand for this journey. We have a final example from the S.Rly from here which is a two coupon monthly return to Ford (Devon) dated 20-05-1950 and serial of 2865, this section of line closed in 1964 and a few remains can be spotted with careful exploration. At one time though there was clearly local use for this long lost railway facility. St. Budeaux had the Victoria Road affix added in 1949 and then had 'Halt' added to this between 1965 & 1969 (R.V.J. Butt). I cannot recall ever seeing a ticket with 'Halt', although surely they should exist, as this renaming was in place for 4 years, although the station I think was destaffed in 1968, there should also be issues using this name as per multiprinter issues from Plymouth. Will keep an eye open for an example and let you know. Our first issue is a Western Region 3rd class child single to Ford (Devon) dated 11-04-1959 with a serial of 4900 indicating a solid demand. Next a straightforward single to Plymouth dated 02-06-1965 with a serial of 8693. Finally we feature a two coupon child return to Bere Ferrers dated 23-01-1965 with an expected low serial of 0010. Now we move onto some travel agency issues from Plymouth. Firstly a GWR first class two coupon from Plymouth North Road 4 to Devonport in manuscript, dated 11-02-1965 with a serial of 176, obviously bought for a collection. Another two coupon issue from 4, this time from Millbay, dated 30-09-1965 to Brent in manuscript. More to follow.






