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GENERAL CATALOGUE

In this catalogue, tickets within each price band are sorted firstly into company (i.e., pregrouping and pre-nationalisation), then British Railways regional order (i.e., Northern, Eastern, London Midland, Scottish, Southern and Western regions).

ORDERING GUIDELINES

Tickets from this catalogue will be processed on a 'First Come, First Served' automated basis. To give you the best chance of securing the tickets you want, use the online facility (using your email address and password), which many of you are now familiar with. Once an order has been submitted online, the system will inform you which tickets are available instantly. You can submit further orders from the same catalogue, which gives you the flexibility of ordering second choice tickets. Orders will be processed within three working days. Payment processes can be via: PayPal; Credit/Debit Cards (WorldPay Pay by Link); bank transfer or cheque.

We will continue to process orders received via email/telephone/post as soon as possible.

All tickets offered in this catalogue are in at least "very good" condition unless otherwise stated in the legend (see below).

LEGEND A: indicates ticket is unissued and has originated from an Audit Office

G: indicates ticket is grubby or soiled **M:** indicates ticket has been mounted

We divert from the Plymouth District briefly to process 2 modern edmondsons from East Yorkshire which have just come into the collection. Firstly we have an undated but clipped twice 5 Day Return from SELBY to Brough. The NLC is 8051, which is British Aerospace at Brough. The NLC is preceded by H.S.A. Co., do not know what this stands for. There were many variations of issues from this NLC from various local stations to cater for British Aerospace workers going to and from work and they were issued from within the works. Our issue has a high serial of 7103. There is much more to learn about tickets from 8051 I feel. The other issue is an unclipped blue text on white card from HULL PARAGON to Cottingham dated 05-03-1981 with a low serial of 0038. If you presented the ticket to the 'conductor' of the East Yorks Motor Services Ltd. Omnibus' you would be given a setright to travel on the bus from Paragon station to Cottingham without charge. Anyway it is pleasing to see an example in nice condition and fully dated.

SEVERED HALVES FROM THE PLYMOUTH DISTRICT. Hundreds of severed halves have been collected from the Plymouth District over the past 35 plus years. They are all relevant because so many Plymouth area stations/halts were closed in the 1950's if not before, for example, ALBERT ROAD HALT in 1947. Now I have never seen an Edmondson featuring this halt which was unstaffed with tickets being issued by the guard, therefore a severed half punch ticket will suffice. There was also much military traffic with the Royal Navy leading which leads to some interesting issues and severed halves are OK. At one time Plymouth had quite a suburban network and I am quite content with the return of a first class issue from Plymouth Millbay to Plympton, although the date is illegible, or how about the outward half of a priv. from here to Cornwood pre-printed dated 04-10-1957 with a serial of 1459. Finally we should not forget the water traffic from Millbay Docks which was significant. We will only feature selected issues of course to stay focussed.






